CANADA

Nestlé Waters Canada's (NWC) Ontario bottling facility is located in Puslinch, Ontario and draws its water from sources in Aberfoyle and Erin. As illustrated below, our operation makes a significant contribution to local and provincial economies.

JOBS



315 workers directly employed with a combined labour income of \$25.2 million.

LOCAL PURCHASES



Local purchases of \$85.2 million in goods and services from Ontario businesses.

TAX REVENUE



Total tax revenue of \$8.79 million including \$1.00 million in local property taxes and \$1.27 million in income taxes paid by NWC employees.

REGIONS (Wellington/Bruce/Grey/Huron/Perth Counties and Region of Waterloo)

JOBS



212 workers directly employed with a combined labour income of \$15.2 million.

LOCAL PURCHASES



Local purchases of \$2.3 million in goods and services from businesses in the region.

TAX REVENUE



Total tax revenue of \$1.98 million including \$1.00 million in local property taxes and \$0.77 million in income taxes paid by NWC employees.

WELLINGTON COUNTY (Guelph, Erin, Minto, Centre Wellington, Guelph-Eramosa, Mapleton, Wellington North, Puslinch)

JOBS



102 workers directly employed with a combined labour income of \$7.3 million.

LOCAL PURCHASES



Local purchases of \$0.8 million in goods and services from businesses across the county.

TAX REVENUE



Total tax revenue of \$1.42 million including \$1 million in local property taxes and \$0.37 million in income taxes paid by NWC employees.



RECYCLING

\$1.58 million toward recycling efforts through contributions to Stewardship Ontario's Blue Box Program.
